WHAT WOULD MY RESPONSIBILITIES BE? Homeroom parents are the liaisons between teachers and families. It is a rewarding job that lets you improve the experience of your child and their classmates. Some teachers may want a lot of help (or very little). Here are some things you may be asked to do:

- Communicate with all of the parents (emailing, texting and sometimes calling) sending out reminders about events, activities, parent tips, etc.
- Meet with the classroom teacher(s) to find out their needs and wishes
- Plan and organize class events/parties
- Keeping an up-to-date list of contact information for all parents
- Being a liaison between parents, teachers and leadership.

Due to COVID-19, parties and events look different this year. Parents are not permitted in the school. Parties will need to be planned with the teacher over google meet, zoom or email. Supplies can then be purchased and dropped off.

IMPORTANT NOTE: As a Homeroom Parent, you do not have to do it all! You can designate if you would like to share the role with another parent. Being a Homeroom Parent is fun and a great way to make lasting friendships with other Foundation Families!
