Sports Physical Requirements

- Any student who plans on participating in a sport must have a comprehensive physical. You must use the "Annual Athletic Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation Form" included in the packet. No substitutes such as doctor's notes or other physical forms are acceptable.
- A current School Entrance/Sports Physical: Date of exam within one calendar year (365 days) of first day of school or first day of practice, whichever is appropriate.

Steps to getting a **SPORTS PHYSICAL**:

- 1. Get physical forms from the FACS Athletic Director (Mr. Torino).
- 2. Part A: Health History Questionnaire (blue forms) must be completely filled out and signed by parent/guardian.
- 3. Parent should also complete Student information (top portion) of next section, Part B: Physical Evaluation (yellow forms).
- 4. Make appointment with your Doctor/Medical Home.
- 5. Pages 1 4 must be completely filled out, signed, and stamped by physician, APN, or PA.
- 6. Hand all completed paperwork into FACS Athletic Director (Mr. Torino).
- 7. If the student has a medical diagnosis that requires medication, either regularly or on an as needed basis, the "Medication Administration Form" must be completed and signed by both parent/guardian and physician and returned to the school nurse prior to clearance. Please contact the school nurse for the necessary forms.
- 8. If a student has authorization to self-medicate for asthma or anaphylaxis by his/her physician, the student must also sign the form. He/she is responsible for bringing the medication to all school/sports events.
